

REGIONAL OCCUPATIONAL PROGRAM (ROP)

Course 2020: Music Production and Recording Arts

Description: This is an introductory class to the study of music production and the audio recording arts. It covers basic recording studio skills including analog audio theory, digital audio, signal flow, microphones, mic placement and tracking. Students learn computer based sequencing, signal processing, recording and score editing using Apple's Logic 9 software program. Students will learn about careers available in the music industry and will become familiar with standard music industry business practices. Students will learn techniques relevant to composing in a commercial song format. This course provides a foundation for further study in advanced courses in audio programming.

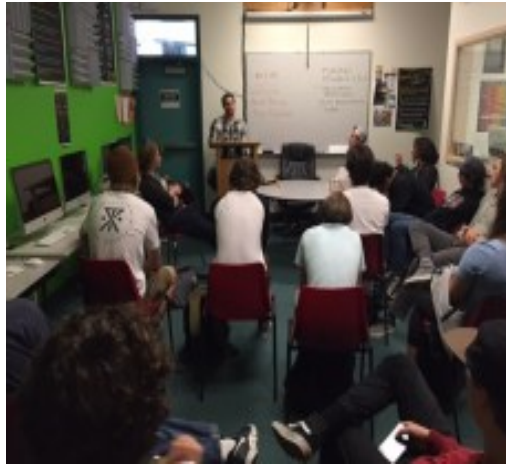
Magnet School

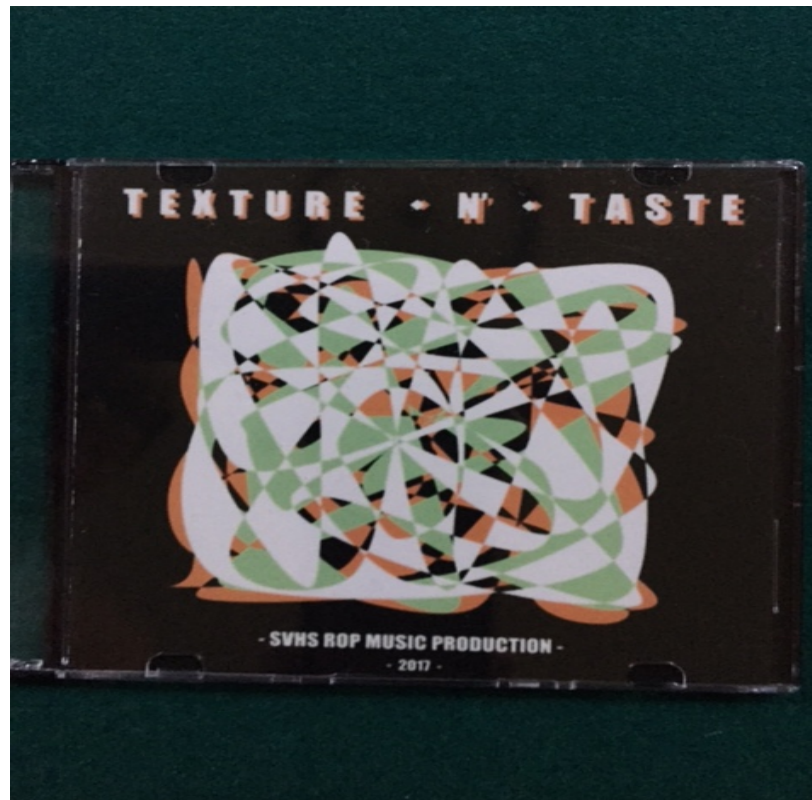
Lennon Bus Educational Tour

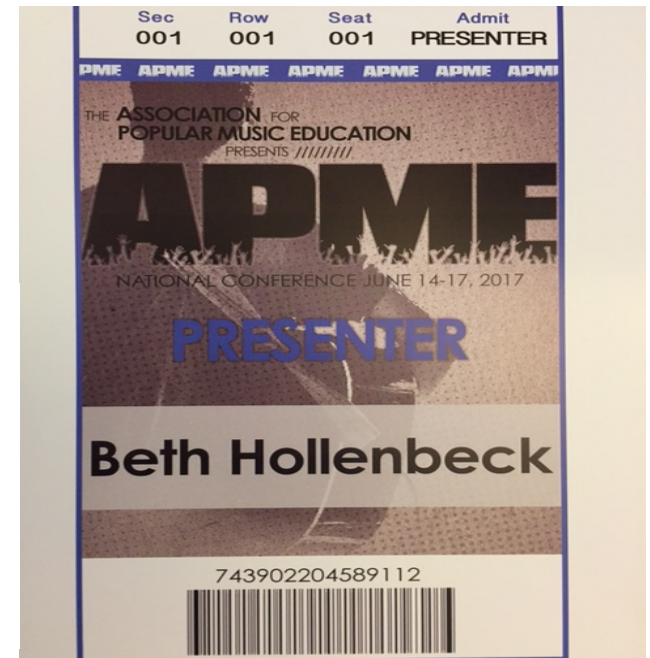
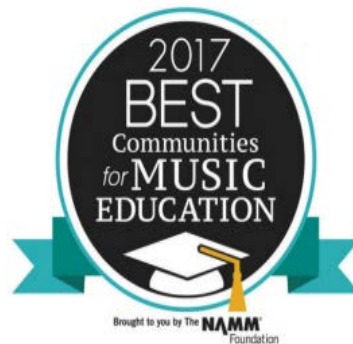
End Product
