Trustee Snyder attended the end of year barbecue for all district employees. He met with Superintendent Krause to review upcoming district activities. He also attended the promotion/graduation ceremonies for Brook Knoll, Vine Hill, SVMS and SVHS.

Trustee Shulman attended the promotion/graduation ceremonies for all three schools, and he attended the end-of-year district barbecue. He attended the inaugural ceremony for Chief Walpole. He attended the first General Plan Advisory Committee public event on June 3rd. He noted that, after doing some data collection using the SVHS graduation program, almost all (174/185) of our students attend college after high school. He attended the suicide prevention stakeholder meeting on June 12th. Finally, he reviewed the Grand Jury report that offers a county-wide view of the overall threat assessment process, and reviews how well the schools are doing in this area.

All of the Trustees thanked the principals and staff for the successful and impressive graduation and promotion ceremonies.

I. SVEF REPORT

Trustee Snyder gave the SVEF report. The Touch a Truck event grossed over \$20K, with the net being approximately \$14K. This amount will go into the SVEF donation fund for next year. They have received the District's request for \$62K in funding donations and this request was approved with the stipulation that it be made in two payments. The SVEF endowment fund has nearly reached its \$500K milestone, and once it reaches this amount SVEF can contribute up to 2% per year towards district contributions. This could represent an additional \$10K per year available to donate to the district. Finally, the next Food Truck event is this Friday, June 16^{th,} 5:00 pm, at SkyPark.
