RESEARCH & INVESTIGATION

- Research Question: *How do towns, cities, and counties, use their local ordinances to address the issue of school overcrowding?*
- Findings:
 1. District's attorney conducted a survey of local ordinances and municipal codes from counties, cities, and towns throughout California (see attachment).
 2. Although local districts have taken various approaches, the majority of the approaches were enacted prior to SB 50
 3. Possible avenues to explore with Town staff include: voluntary mitigation agreements with local developers, zoning, additional taxes and construction fees under the Subdivision Map Act, and land dedications.



NEXT STEPS

- Governing Board to discuss findings and provide District staff direction regarding continuing to research and explore other avenues for mitigation.
