RED RIBBON WEEK OCTOBER 22 - OCTOBER 28, 2016

WHEREAS, the Board of Education (the “Board”) of the Scotts Valley Unified School District (the “District”) is committed to promote the safety of students in Scotts Valley public schools by designating Red Ribbon Week

WHEREAS, the Board pledges to help children grow up safe, healthy, and drug-free. Children who are regularly made aware about the dangers of drug use are 42% less likely to use drugs than those who are not, yet only a quarter of teens report having such conversations from parents, educators, and community members. During the week of October 22 – October 28 we plan to bring awareness to student safety by promoting the following:

WHEREAS, as parents, educators, and community members, we will talk to our children and the children in our lives about the dangers of substance abuse

WHEREAS, we will help establish clear guidelines for our children about the dangers of substance abuse

WHEREAS, we will set a good example for our children by not using illegal drugs or medicine without a prescription

WHEREAS, we will monitor our children's behavior and enforce appropriate consequences, so that appropriate guidelines are respected

WHEREAS, we will encourage family, friends, educators, and community members to follow the same guidelines to keep children safe from substance abuse

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Scotts Valley Unified School District Board of Trustees proclaims October 22 – October 28, 2017 to be RED RIBBON WEEK.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Scotts Valley Unified School District Board of Trustees strongly encourages all parents, educators, and members of our community to join in this observance.
