Back-to-School Tips for Bicyclists and Motorists

Hopping on a bicycle and pedaling to school is healthy, fun and good for the environment. Natomas streets are likely to be filled with pedal-pushing students when classes resume Wednesday, Aug. 9. We urge motorists and bicyclists to recognize that and exercise caution while traveling near schools.

Nothing is more important than the health of our students and community. Disaster can strike quickly when people are careless, unsafe, or fail to share the road. Whether you're behind the wheel of a car or bike, drive with care, obey traffic laws, be predictable, and stay alert at all times.

California law requires motorists to pass no closer than 3 feet from a bicyclist traveling in the same direction. That alone won't ensure safety, however, so please abide by the following tips:
