Breakfast at Six Sites

School	Average Daily Participation
Blackford Elem.	110 (includes 1 preschool class)
Lynhaven Elem.	61 (includes 1 preschool class, expected to reach 100 by end of 2017)
Rosemary Elem.	146 (includes 6 preschool class)
Sherman Oaks Elem.	200 (includes 6 preschool class)
Campbell Middle	109
Monroe Middle	29

Types of Service

Before School

Pros: Students receive nutritious meal prior to learning

Cons: Participation and staffing

Second Chance Breakfast

(Breakfast at First Recess)

Pros: Higher participation. Students receive a nutritious meal toward the beginning of the school day.

Cons: Scheduling



Types of Service

Breakfast in the Classroom

Pros: All students have access to a meal to aid learning. High Participation.

Cons: Burden to staff, Cleanliness, Labor, Buy-in

Vending Machine

Pros: No labor, student access, good for schools with low participation

Cons: Breakdowns and glitches, speed, student input error.

Breakfast vending machine

USDA Requirements

- Four Meal Components: Protein, Grains, Fruit or Vegetable, Milk
- Students must select 3 of the 4 components
- Breakfast must be between 400 to 500 calories
- Only 10% calories can be from fat
- No trans fat
- 540 milligrams of sodium or less
- Must offer two types of fruit or vegetables
- We do not serve chocolate milk at breakfast



Program Cost

Reimbursement Per Breakfast

Average Meal Reimbursement = \$2.15

Subtract Average Meal Cost = \$1.39

Revenue Before Op. Costs / Meal = \$0.76

Labor & Operations Cost

Child Nutrition Assistant = \$52.00 per day

Administration & Delivery = \$8.41 per day

Operations (IDC) = \$11.03 per day

Total Labor & Operations = \$71.44 per day

Break-Even Point

\$71.44 divided by \$0.76 = 94 meals
