Attached please find a resolution passed on December 7, 2017 by the Governing Board of the Campbell Union School District that supports the reauthorization of the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). Please note that in the resolution, the Governing Board does not endorse any particular CHIP bill in Congress, but instead advocates for the basic principle that all children in the United States should have medical coverage.

The Governing Board of Campbell Union School District respectfully urges you to take action to ensure that 9 million children in America – including 1.3 million kids in California – do not lose their CHIP health insurance.

The Campbell Union School District serves approximately 7,500 students, as well as 400 infants and toddlers, in Northern California. The District operates 9 public elementary schools and 3 middle schools, as well as 8 preschools and an infant care program.
