NARRATIVE OF AGREEMENT:

Provide a brief narrative of the proposed changes in compensation and attach a copy of the Tentative Agreement.

A 4.37% on going increase retroactive to 7/1/2017 on the base salary of the unrepresented Preschool Permit Teachers and Confidential Employees, Managers, Administrators and Superintendent(s). The retroactive increases will apply only to base salary and will not apply to the hourly, stipend, extra duty or overtime work. This agreement concludes negotiations for the 2017-2018 school year for all employees. For Confidential, Managers and Administrators, the district will increase its health benefit contribution to equal the combined average of the three-tiered caps offered to the three bargaining groups (CSEA, SRFT, and SRTA) effective Jan 1, 2018. The new revised caps \$666 empl only, \$1,156 empl + 1, and \$1,503 empl + 2. In alignment with the San Rafael Teachers Association Tentative Agreement, the unrepresented Pre-School Teachers shall also receive an increase to the three-tiered health benefit cap effective Jan. 1, 2018 as follows: \$588 employee only, \$1,174 employee +1, and \$1,527 employee +2. This results in an increase of about 7% in H&W costs.
