**SAN RAFAEL CITY HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT,  
RE-ACTIVATION OF ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, The California Education Code (EC) sections 52501, 52502, 52503 and California Code of Regulations, Title 5 Section 10560 allows unified or high school districts to establish separate adult schools, and;

WHEREAS, the Board believes that education is a lifelong process and that it is important for individuals to continuously develop new skills. Eligible adults shall be offered opportunities to enroll in programs and courses that develop academic and workforce skills and, as appropriate, lead to completion of requirements for high school graduation, and;

WHEREAS, Adult Education Program funding will be provided through the Adult Education Block Grant (AB104) and;

WHEREAS, San Rafael City Schools has the opportunity to re-activate an adult school to offer the following programs for adults 18 years of age and older:

- 1) English as a Second Language
- 2) Adult Basic Education / Adult Secondary Education
- 3) Short-term Career Technical Education
- 4) Adults with disabilities
- 5) Older adult work-force re-entry
- 6) Adults supporting child academic success
- 7) Pre-apprenticeship
- 8) Basic English
- 9) Basic Math

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that San Rafael City Schools, High School District will provide Adult Education to provide lifelong educational opportunities and services to adult learners. These opportunities and services are to address the unique needs of individuals and communities by providing adults with the knowledge and skills necessary to participate effectively as citizens, workers, family members, and consumers of goods and services.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution be submitted to California Department of Education.
