Intra-Year Interventions

Milpitas High School Intra-Year Progress Monitoring and Intervention

A-G Progress Monitoring

- Intra-year grade tracking database, designed to monitor student progress toward A-G completion.
- Academic Study Team (AST) Group of Counselors and Admin meet bi-weekly to discuss students.

EOS

- Equal Opportunity Schools work with MHS to identify students who may show aptitude to be successful in AP coursework given opportunity and encouragement.

Naviance

- Naviance is a comprehensive college and career readiness solution that helps districts and schools align student strengths and interests to postsecondary goals, improving student outcomes and connecting learning to life.

Academic Study Team (AST)

Intra-Year A-G Progress Monitoring

1

- Data Reports are run and updated every three weeks with all students currently receiving a D or F in at least 1 class.
- Core Classes are isolated within the data set
- Students are sorted by highest number of D's/F's in core classes

2

- AST Team: Counselors and Administrators, SLS Coordinator, Cassy
- Students are prioritized by “need” to receive academic counseling and possible intervention support or SST Referral
- The list of students can be approached in multiple ways

Ensure access to Advanced Placement courses and expand course offerings driven by student need.

- MHS continues to work with students in providing them opportunity and encouragement to participate in AP courses. MHS has seen an increase in AP Government due to the newly identified and interviewed students

2

Evaluate and continue partnership with Equal Opportunity Schools to identify missing students in AP courses. Implement strategies to increase AP participation.

- The EOS staff identifies students by using their survey and our student data. They provide us with a list of trusted adults and the possible class the student may be ready for/interested in taking depending on their individual responses and past academic history.



Staff will monitor student success as measured by class grades and Advanced Placement exam passing rate.

- MHS would like to create our own survey to identify students and continue with the one on one interviews. Moving forward. MHS would also use our PSAT data and AVID to identify students. The hope would be to apply the savings (cost for EOS is currently \$10,000) If we are able to reduce this cost we may be able to purchase practice materials, reach out to outside agencies for tutorial support/interventions and support the cost of the actual AP exam.


EOS: Ethnicity Breakdown

Naviance *Career Pathway Tool:*

Aligning student strengths and interests to postsecondary goals, improving student outcomes

1

Tools and Curriculum Resources

- Surveys and assessments to help students, parents, counselors, and teachers to identify students strengths, skills, interests, and aptitude.
- Curriculum to guide students to explore and develop 4-year high school plans, college and career plans, college profiles and admissions, and more.

2

4-Year Plan and A-G/Post-Secondary Eligibility Tracking

- Master schedule course and transcript data is uploaded allowing students to choose their courses aligned to their post-secondary goals, and track their progress toward their college and career goals.
- Data and reports to assist counselors and teachers identify students off-track and provide guidance and interventions. Also provides data on matriculation to college and completion for alumni.

3

Access for ALL Students

- Naviance would allow for all students and families to have access to high school, college, and career planning, resources and tools at any time while enrolled.
- With counselor guidance and collaboration, curriculum and tools will be used in Freshman Life Management classes, AVID, academies, ROTC, and other learning communities at all grade levels.

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
