Gaps and Strategies

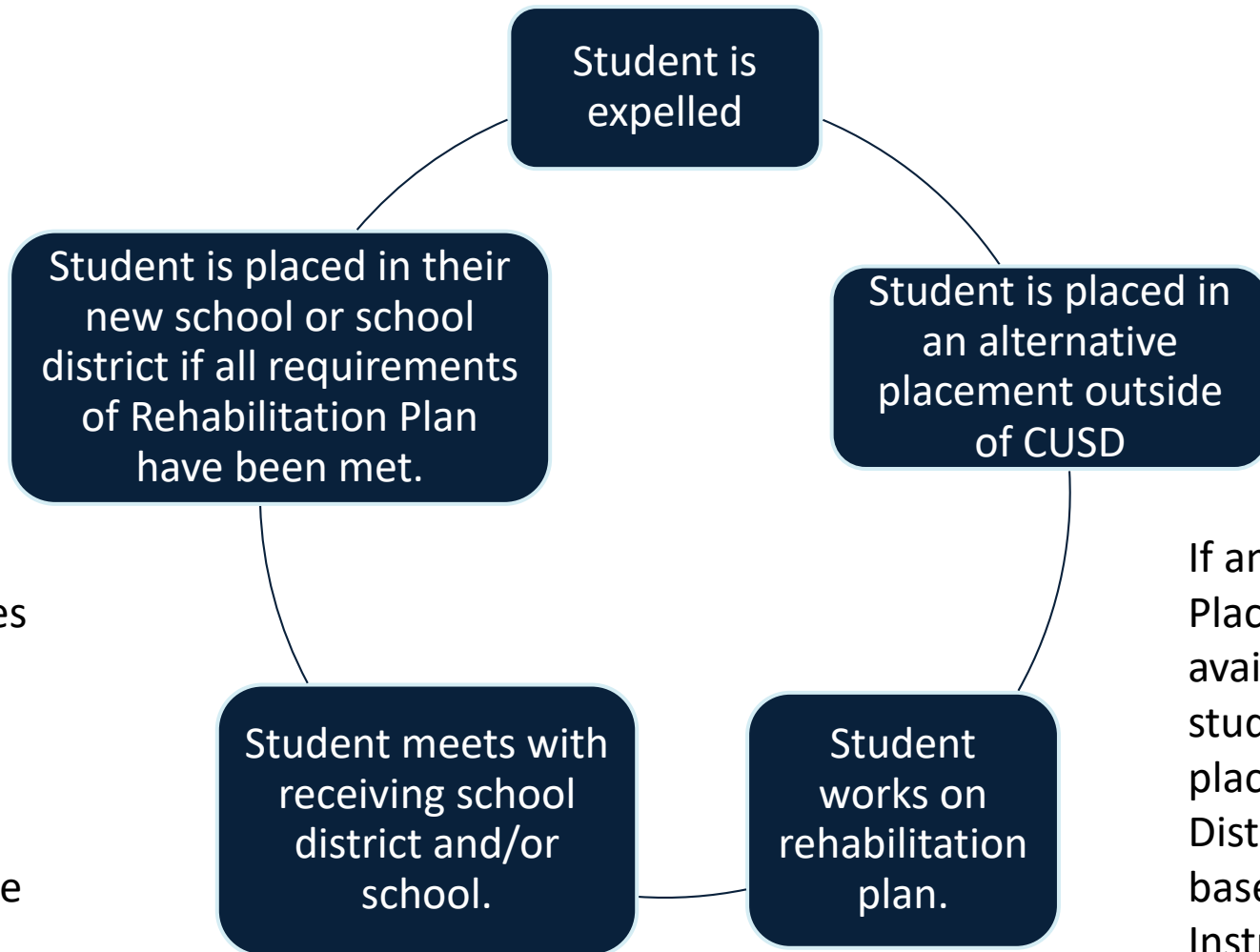
Gaps:

1. Options for elementary aged expelled students
2. Access to counseling and mental health supports for expelled students
3. Lack of in-house Alternative Placement Program
4. Reduction of school sites options for students serving a Suspended Action Expulsion
5. Limited Alternative Placement options for expelled youth outside of District/Staffing for our Home-based Instruction Program

Strategies:

1. Home Based Instruction program
2. District will provide counseling services and/or make referral to an outside agency.
3. Working with each site to align their systems of support to ensure their MTSS framework is based on data and responsive to student needs.
4. PLCs (Professional Learning Community and MTSS (Multi Tiered Systems of Support)
5. Home-based instruction with Teacher on Special Assignment (TOSA) and/or retired certificated staff

Expulsion Process



If student does not meet the plan, the student's placement in the alternative program is extended.

If an Alternative Placement is not available the student will be placed in District's Home-based Instruction program

Next Steps

- Continue working with site administrators to decrease suspensions and expulsions
- Structuring the Home-based Instruction program to include key components of an Alternative Placement program.
- Maintain partnership with the County's Community Day School program
