Rationale

- Seniors have expressed the need to revisit issues such as drug and sex education from a more mature perspective.
- Reduce stress level for college application and career exploration
- Returning graduates discuss need for learning more practical life skills.
- Social justice curriculum will help students to understand their advantages and disadvantages because of their background and how this affects their lives.



Course Overview

A hands-on practical guide to life after high school, including support for college application process, exploring gap year options and careers.

The course will include education on drug and alcohol use, sex ed, and mental health.

The class will also explore issues connected to social justice and help students to clarify their own belief system.


Finally, the class will include practical instruction in the skills and knowledge for adult life such as cooking, financial literacy, etc.



Course Materials

Course materials will include current articles and handouts provided by the teacher. There is no course textbook.

We will also bring in speakers such as local business owners, mental health professionals, drug and alcohol speakers, and recent alumni.
