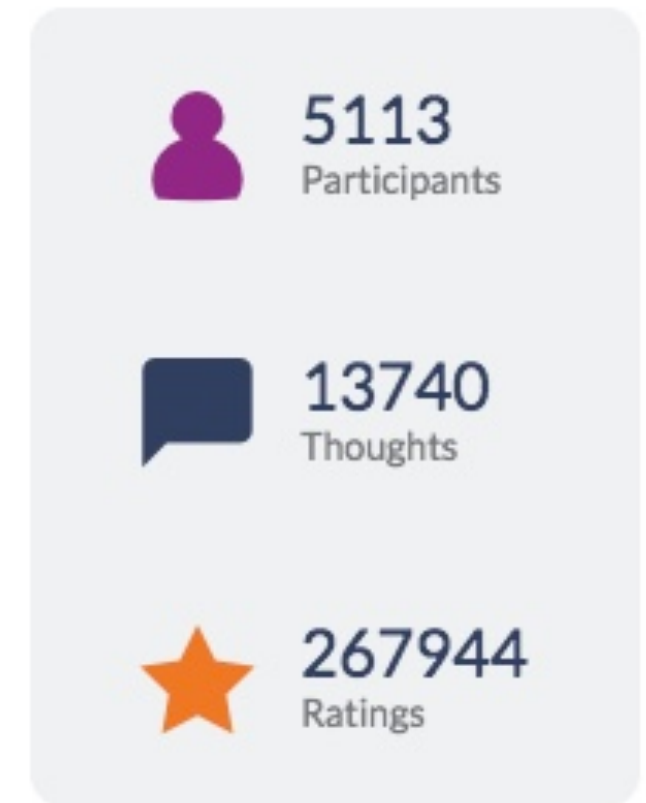

A new approach to School Climate Perceptions

- ▶ Launched April 2018
- ▶ Conducted during school
- ▶ Gr 3-8 students
 - 84% Shared Thoughts
 - 78% explored Thoughts
 - 60% Rated Thoughts
- ▶ Incorporate into LCAP process
- ▶ More authentic input and faster results

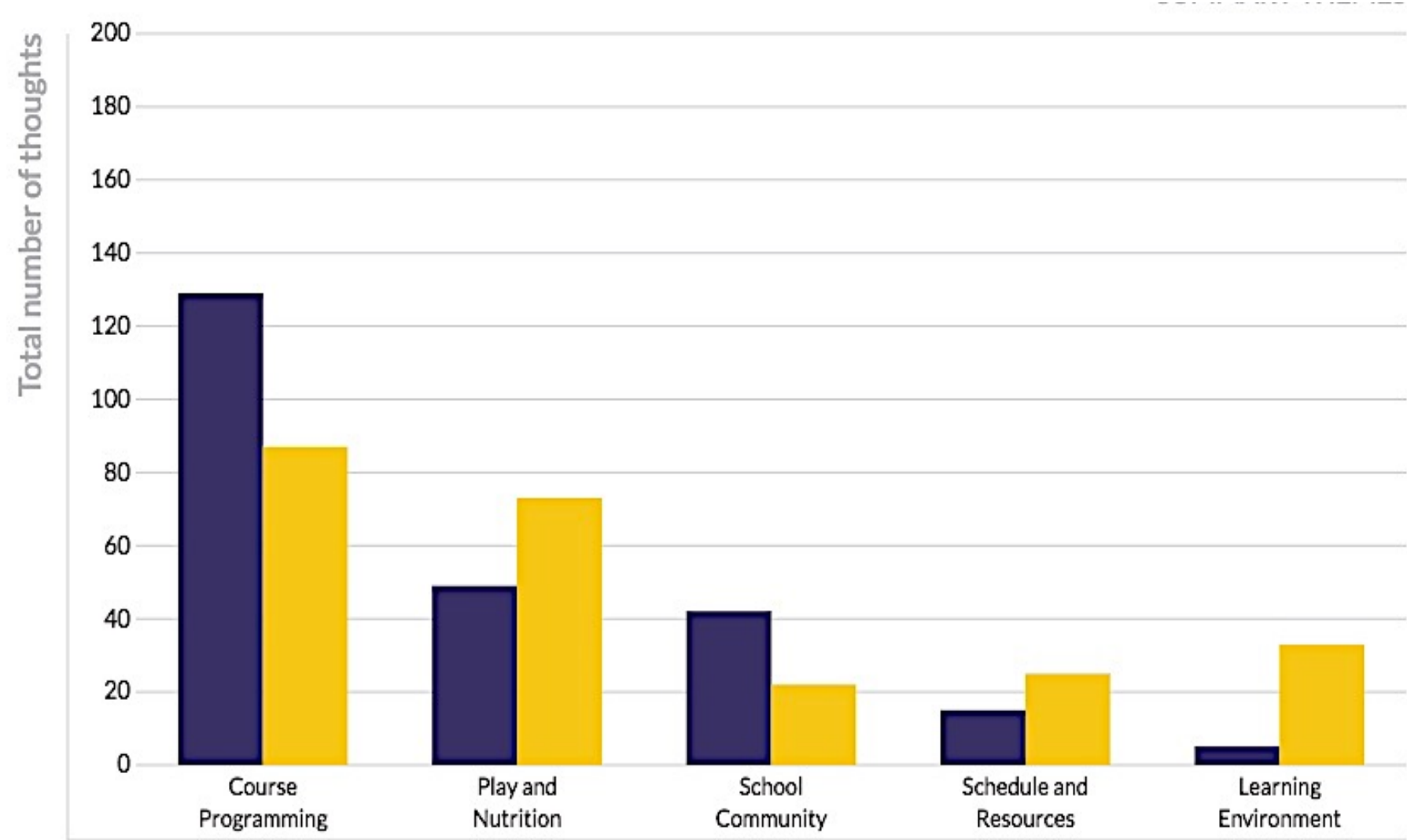

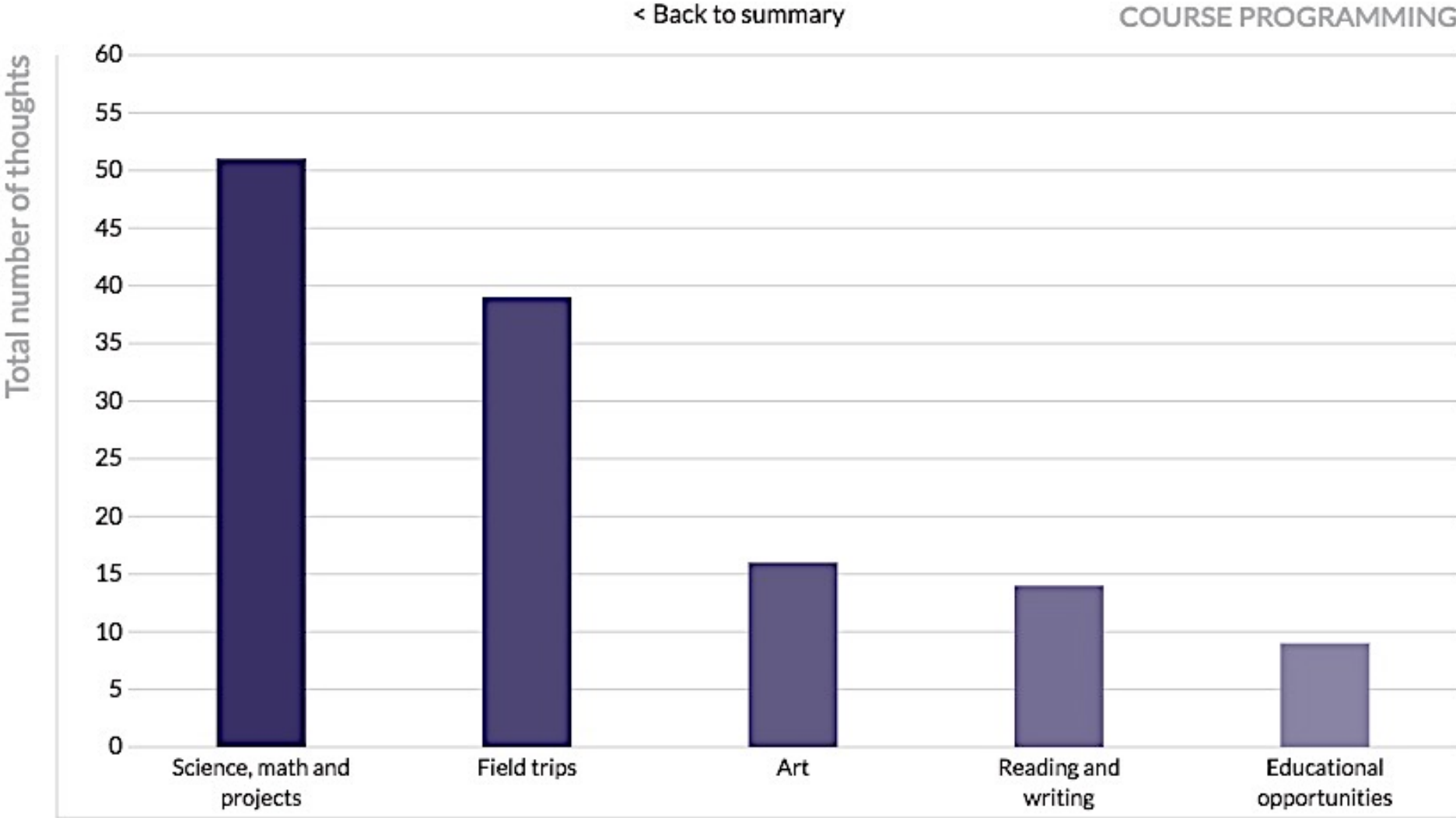

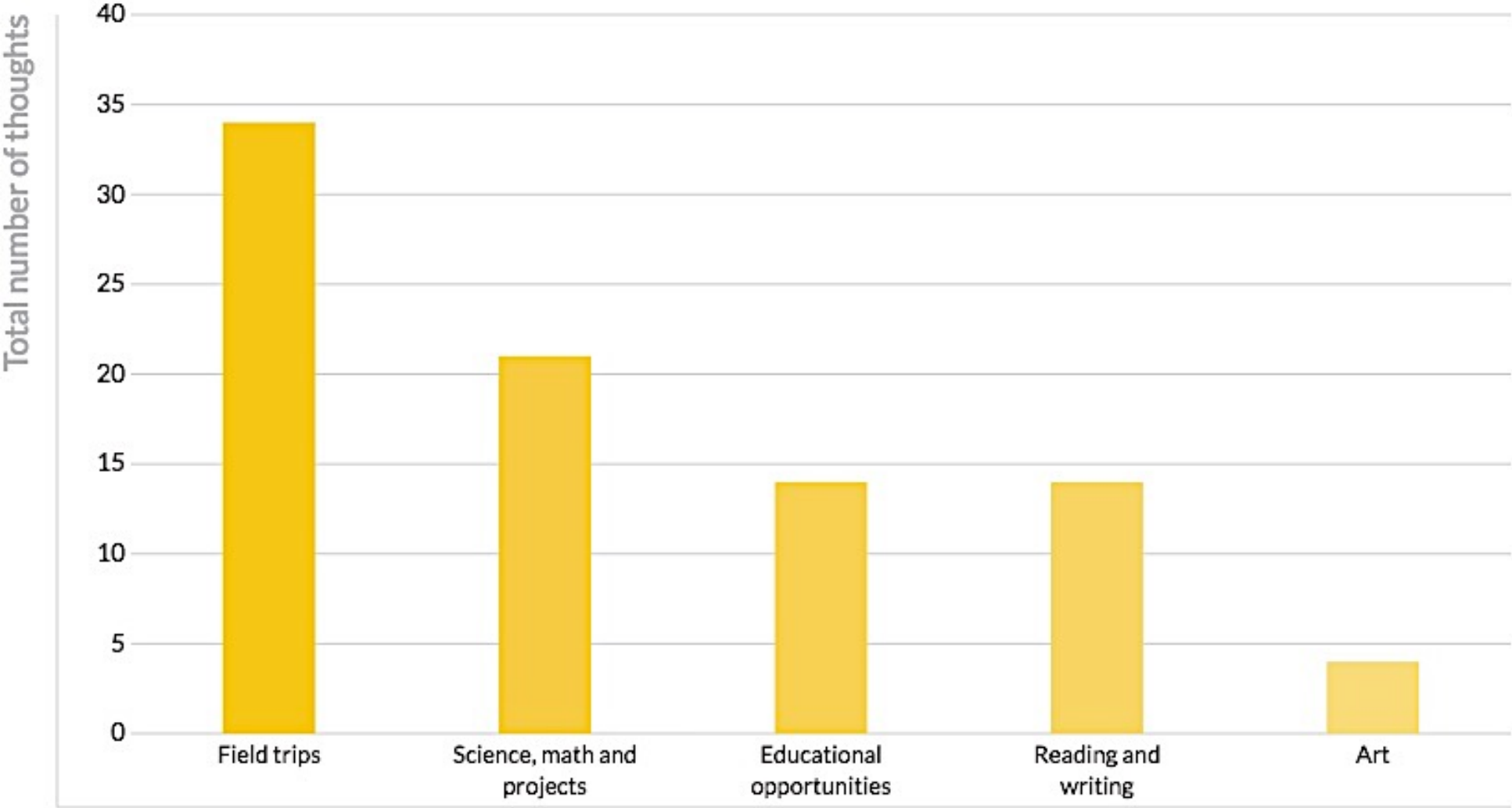
