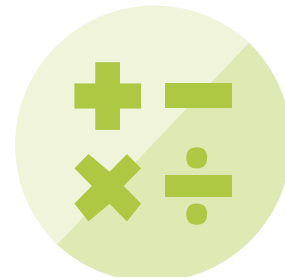
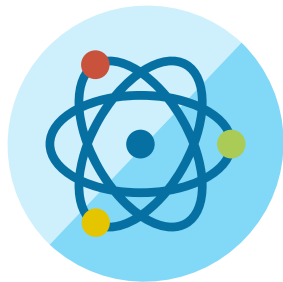

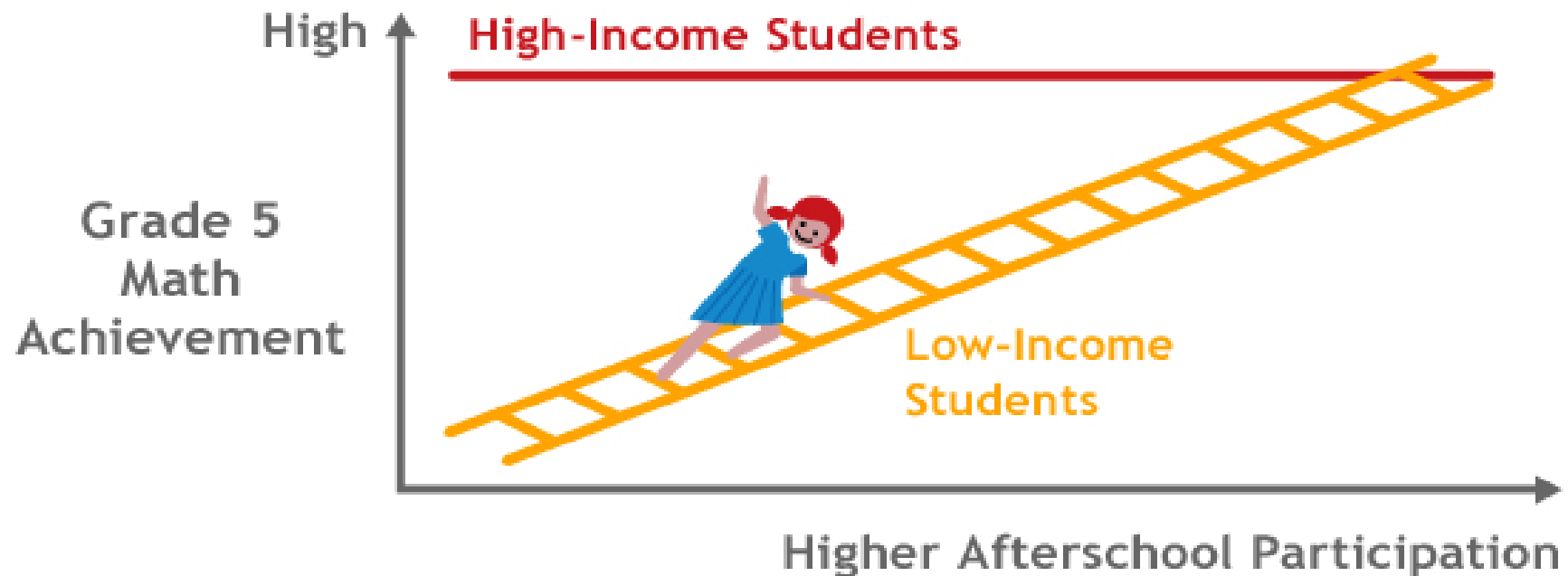

ASES Supports Students' Success

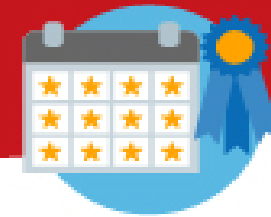
Consistent participation in afterschool programs leads to improved:

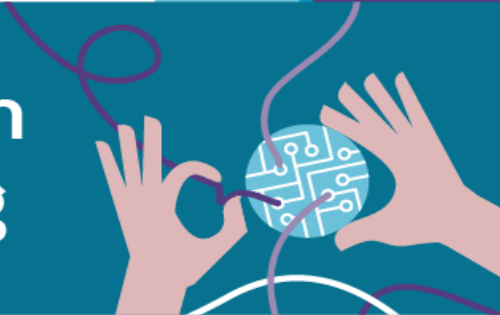

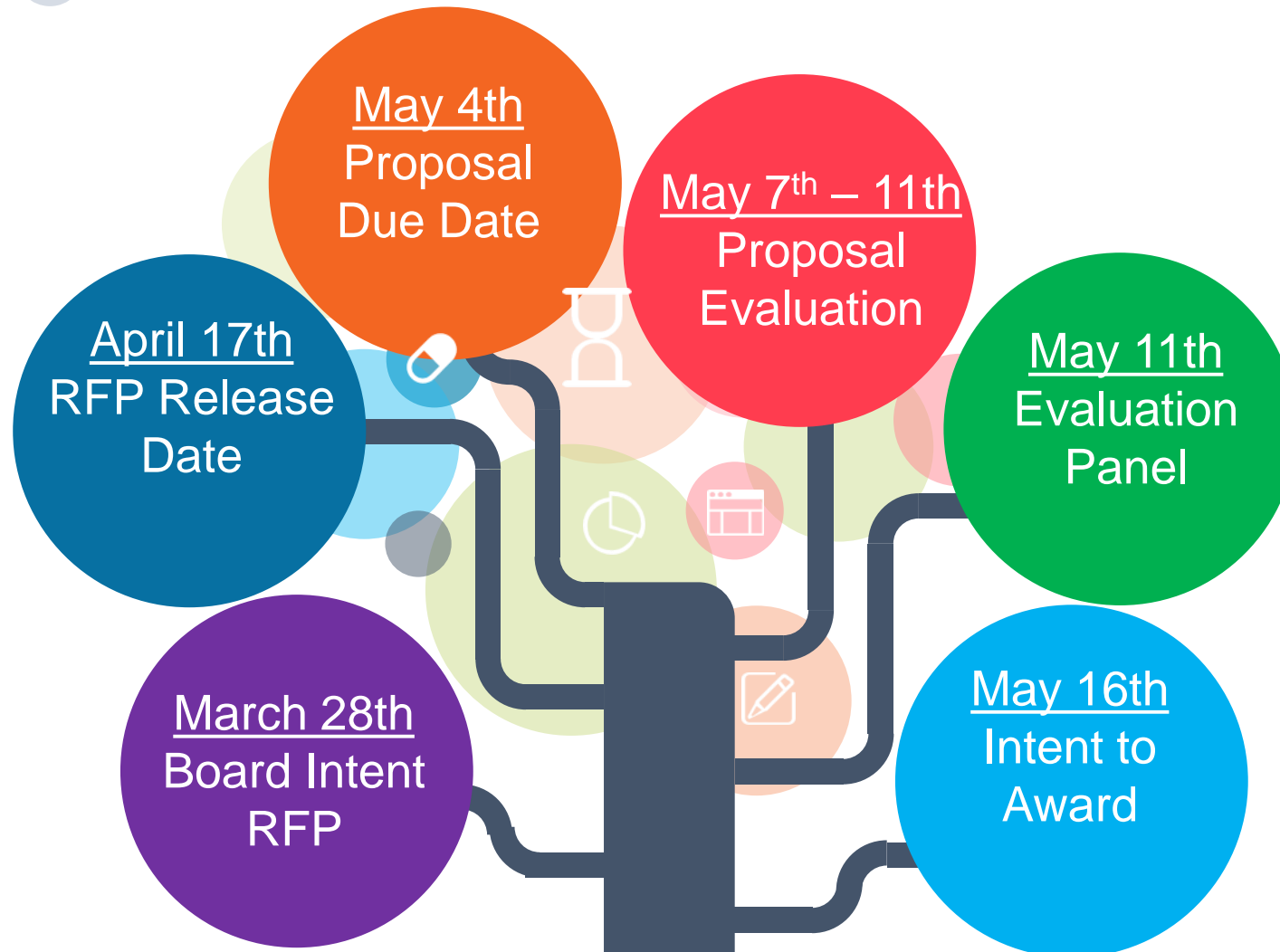
