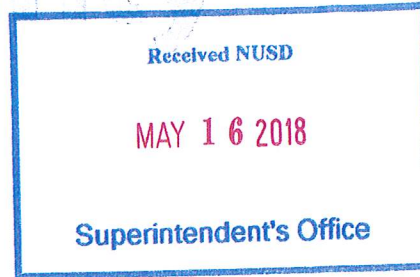

Dear President Dosick and Superintendent Evans:

As a result of the *Williams* Settlement, Education Code section 1240 requires that county offices of education visit schools in their county that ranked in deciles 1 to 3 on the 2012 Base Academic Performance Index (API) (*Williams* schools). Education Code section 1240(c)(2)(G) requires the county superintendent of schools to send quarterly reports regarding the results of school site visits and reviews conducted each quarter to the governing boards of the school districts with *Williams* schools. The results can then be made public at a regularly scheduled and noticed meeting of each district's governing board.

This letter serves as the 2017-2018 Third Quarterly Report for the Natomas Unified School District (District).

Instructional Materials and Facilities

During the third quarter of Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-2018, the Sacramento County Office of Education (SCOE) staff did not conduct any site reviews of instructional materials or facilities.



School Accountability Report Card

The School Accountability Report Card (SARC) of each of the District's *Williams* schools was reviewed for accuracy as required by Education Code section 1240(c)(2)(l). The information contained in the schools' SARCs was generally clear and accurate. In order to provide assistance in preparing your District's SARCs for next year, a chart (Exhibit A) is enclosed that provides detailed suggestions for further improving the District's SARCs.

Teacher Vacancies and Misassignments


