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Feasibility Analysis


- Feasibility Committee
 - Parents, teachers, classified employees, and wide range of community members from Santa Monica & Malibu
- Meetings held: March 13, May 1 and July 10
- Endorsed SFID approach and bond amounts for November 2018 ballot
 - Malibu - \$195 million
 - Santa Monica - \$485 million

Voter Opinion Research

April 2018, *Goodwin Simon Strategic Research* completed public opinion survey of 523 likely voters:


- Santa Monica - natural support @ 68%
 - Information increased support to 70%
- Malibu - natural support @ 58%
 - Information increased support to 61%
- Top bond uses across District include:
 - Fix leaky roofs
 - Remove hazardous materials from schools
 - Improve facilities to support math, science and technology instruction
 - Repair floors, walls and windows

TOP PRIORITIES FOR USE OF BOND FUNDS: MALIBU




Qualitative Research

As of July 17, 604 SMMUSD residents responded:

- 79.1% of respondents have children that currently attend SMMUSD schools
- 75.5% of respondents have children that attended SMMUSD schools in the past
- Santa Monica: 534 responses / 142 comments
- Malibu: 108 responses / 36 comments
- Outside of District (online link) 161 responses / 42 comments

Survey Common Themes

Santa Monica

The schools are sorely in need of air conditioning. Very little learning occurs in overheated classrooms.


My daughter was in a portable classroom last year. They are designed to be temporary and are being used as a permanent solution to our space problems.
