In conjunction to SMMUSD's LCAP Goals the *Digital Learning Program* will provide equitable access to mobile devices for all students while supporting the integration of instructional technologies within SMMUSD's instructional practices and adopted curriculum. Students will be able to use digital learning content and tools that will prepare them to be global citizens that are ready for college and careers within schools that are safe, socially responsive and academically rigorous.

Digital Learning Program Goals:

Goal 1: Integrated Instructional Technologies for all students and staff:

- Staff will utilize instructional technologies to design student driven lessons that personalize student learning through the use of data driven instructional practices while leveraging instructional technologies to improve student achievement in support of the California Content Standards.
- Students will utilize instructional technologies to take an active role in their learning of the California Content Standards through the use of digital tools to communicate, construct knowledge, use critical thinking skills and the produce of meaningful learning experiences that allow them to work in highly effective teams.
- Technology integration will be emphasized throughout the instructional framework.

Goal 2: Digital Citizenship Curriculum and Family Engagement:

- Students will learn and be empowered to make safe, appropriate, and ethical decisions while using digital resources inclusive of digital and online media literacy.
- Parents/Guardians will be aware of instructional, safety, privacy, and student privacy issues and how to have meaningful conversations with their students related to the use of digital tools.

Goal 3: Increase Device to Student Ratio

- To provide 1:1 device to student ratio that will facilitate anywhere any time learning for students 3-12th grade, allowing student to take home their school-issued devices and providing equity and access to technology resources for Prek-2nd grade.

Goal 4: Professional Development and Instructional Support

- Provide all staff with just in time and ongoing professional development and support needed to successfully accomplish effective use of instructional technologies through the use of personalized learning strategies for students, teachers, administrators and staff.

Goal 5: Infrastructure and Technical Support

- Ensure that resources are allocated to have appropriate technical support at all school sites.
- Continued to allocate resources and support of network infrastructure
