






# Highlights of 2017-2018

  - c. Obscene acts, Profanity and Vulgarity
  - d. Bullying


# Total Suspensions



# CUSD Suspension Data 2013-2018




# Total Number of Students Suspended




# County and District Trends 2013-2018

## District vs. County Suspension Data


