- “Would you participate in a District-sponsored insurance program that covers the repair of accidental damage to a Chromebook, with no deductible, for \$33 per school year?”

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
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### Parent Survey Results - Monroe Middle School



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
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### Parent Survey Results - Rolling Hills Middle School



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
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
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Parent Survey Results - Monroe Middle School Insurance Plan




Parent Survey Results - Rolling Hills Middle School Insurance Plan




# Student Survey Data

# Student Survey Comments

## Student Voices:

- Optional Insurance Plan for \$33 per year




# Teacher Expectations
