

Section 4: The Superintendent of Schools of Marin County is hereby requested to call a special all-mail election of the said special tax to be held on August 30, 2005. The County Registrar of Voters is hereby requested and authorized to: 1.) Set forth all ballots relating to said all-mail election to be mailed to qualified voters of the San Rafael High District in the manner provided by law. 2.) Collect and count all ballots as of August 30, 2005.

Section 5: If any section, subsection, phrase, or clause of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this resolution. The Governing Board declares that it would have adopted this resolution and each section, subsection, phrase, or clause thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, phrases, or clauses shall be declared invalid.

Section 6: The Secretary of the San Rafael High School District's Governing Board is hereby authorized and directed to certify to the due adoption of this resolution and to transmit a copy hereof so certified to the Superintendent of Schools of Marin County, the Marin County Board of Supervisors, and to file a copy hereof to certified with the County Clerk of Marin County.
