



Santa Rosa City Schools - Coherent System of Continuous Improvement

Santa Rosa City Schools has received a Low Performing Student Block Grant allocating funds based on the 2017 CAASPP Results that is to provide additional services through professional learning, instructional materials and direct student support services. Funding is to be expended from April 2019 to June 2021 with reporting of progress and impact aligned with the District LCAP.

Ridgeway High School was identified as a CSI School resulting from a low graduation rate (below 67%) based on the 2018 CA Dashboard, and will receive funding to be expended from April 2019 to June 2020. Funding is to provide additional professional learning, instructional program improvement and direct student support services.
