# Metrics By Goal

## ■ Goal 1 and 2:

- Fall Interim Assessments
  - *Includes CAASPP Interim Assessment Blocks (IABs), FastBridge and Illuminate Assessments*

## ■ Goal 3:

- Absenteeism
- Suspensions



# Considerations:

## ■ Hand-Scoring ELA student responses:

- Not all ELA scores are available as items that require hand-scoring need to be completed before students scores are accessible

## ■ Illuminate assessment performance bands:

- Illuminate assessment performance bands are different from CAASPP IAB performance levels

## ■ Material not yet covered:

- CAASPP Interim Assessment Blocks (IABs) - Math might have questions that have not been taught by teachers yet
- Grade 6 Math better aligned with “The Number System” IAB instead of the one administered “Expressions and Equations”

## ■ Participation rates:

- Malibu Middle and High School did not administer winter interims given the loss of instructional days



# Q3 Initial Findings

## ■ Highlights:

- Increase in percentage of students performing “Above Standard” from Fall to Winter – across all subgroups in ELA and Math (except Math-SPED)
- Decrease in percentage of students performing “Below Standard” from Fall to Winter – across all subgroups in ELA and Math (except Math-SPED)
- Have data to track student progress from Fall-Winter-Summative CAASPP assessment
- 37% decrease in number of suspensions compared to last year (for the same period of time)



# Q3 Initial Findings

## ■ Areas of Need:

- Performance of SED, SPED, EL, Black/African American, and Hispanic subgroups lag behind other student groups
- In ELA, SED/EL female students significantly outperform male peers
- In Math, SPED male students significantly outperform female peers
- Grade 9 & 10 ELA performance lags behind Fall performance
- Chronic absenteeism adversely impacts student performance and further exasperates achievement gaps
- Suspension rates are significantly down for non-SED/SPED student groups but remain the same for other subgroups



# Q3 Promising Staff Practices

- Staff reviewed student performance data to find areas of need and celebrate growth
  - All subgroups showed improved performance
  - Students had difficulty with questions that had multiple correct responses
  - Students had difficulty transferring learning to questions that required applying content in novel ways
- Continued implementation of Restorative Justice (level 2 training)
- Staff researching ELA and Math evidence-based supplemental/intervention materials for secondary

# Q3 Considerations for Next Steps

- Explore CDE's forthcoming update of IABs so more focused units can be used (when available) for math
- Train site leaders on how to access student performance data in the CAASPP portal
- Review curriculum guides to plan concrete next steps in addition to grading on ELA handscoring days
  - Select grades will create district specific exemplars and check sets to set higher bar for student writing
- Use existing structures to provide SLT teams with structured time to review interims (IABs) and triangulate data with their plan's identified evidence of student learning
- Maintain current focus on integration of the SJ standards in our curriculum guides, expansion of Project Based Learning and implementation of Restorative Justice
- Develop participation goals to ensure all students have access to interim assessments
