Student Survey Results

- **ESL / Citizenship**
 - 36% enroll to continue some form of education (higher level of schooling and/or vocational training).
 - 34% enroll for employment purposes.
 - 67% of students are interested in ESL and job training classes to happen in conjunction with each other.
 - 41% of students list their work schedule as an educational barrier.
- **Adult Basic Education / Adult Secondary Education**
 - 70% enroll to continue some form of education (higher level of schooling and/or vocational training).
 - 42 % of students are interested in academic and job training classes to happen in conjunction with each other.
 - 51% of students list their work schedule as an educational barrier.
