District can create custom dashboards and identify ways to improve student achievement. This addresses and supports multiple actions of Goals 1 & 2 of the LCAP.		This addendum is for all schools to get add student tracking feature in Illuminate with eduCLIMBER. This will support our MTSS to enable employees on the tier 2 teams like counselors & administrators of MTSS to access reports. Districts can identify data thresholds for reports that are set up to be run at specific intervals to help catch student when low level, early interventions are needed to prevent over identifying of students for 504's & IEPs. This supports the significant disproportionality found in Special Education as well as in the Suspension Data.		The access to reports and the reduced time in person hours would be evident. The quick access to data from the supt, school board, cabinet, principals, counselors and teacher level will be vastly improved over what we can access now with existing & limiting reports in Illuminate Ed.
