



RESOLUTION 2018-19-45
EDUCATION PROTECTION ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, the Provisions of Article XIII, §36 create in the State General Fund an Education Protection Account to receive and disburse the revenues derived from the incremental increase in taxes imposed by Article XII, §36(f); and

WHEREAS, all monies in the Education Protection Account are continuously appropriated for the support of school districts, county offices of education, charter schools, and community college districts; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the legislature that all community college districts, county offices of education, school districts, and charter schools shall have the authority to determine how the monies received from the Education Protection Account are spent within the agency; and

WHEREAS, in the spirit of maintaining transparency, the Governing Board is required to make the spending determinations with respect to monies received from the Education Protection Account in an open session of a public meeting of the Governing Board; and

FURTHERMORE, all monies received from the Education Protection Account shall not be used for any other administrative costs except for audit expenses pursuant to the additional audit requirements imposed by Article XIII, §36 of the California Constitution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Board of the Campbell Union School District determines that monies received from the Education Protection account shall be spent on teacher salaries. This action satisfies the requirements imposed by Article XIII, §36 of the California Constitution.
