Under general supervision, the Groundskeeper performs general gardening and landscaping work, cleans, operates, and maintains facilities in an efficient and safe manner to meet customer needs and support an enriching educational environment for our students, staff, and community. The Groundskeeper applies best practices to complete assigned duties safely, on-time, with a customer service mindset, and in alignment with San José Unified standards and procedures.

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Cleans, operates, and maintains grounds in an efficient and safe manner
- Performs inspections and grounds maintenance programs under general guidance
- Supports furniture and equipment management, including setup and takedown for various events
- Maintains inventory and equipment in an organized, clean, safe, and efficient manner, including performing filter replacements and oil changes
- Safely operates and maintains a variety of equipment, apparatuses, and materials, including but not limited to cleaning and landscape equipment
- Performs both daily and long-term care tasks to keep outdoor spaces safe, healthy, and vibrant
- Maintains the irrigation sprinkler unit
- Collaborates with Lead and Head Groundskeepers
- May assist with training and supporting others
- Maintains accurate records and completes appropriate reporting using San José Unified applications and technology
- Supports safe and healthy swimming pool operation; may record pool readings
- Communicates effectively with customers and co-workers; proactively addresses needs and is responsive to requests

The employee is further required to have the physical, mental, and emotional stamina to fully perform the duties and responsibilities of the position, and the mental acuity to collect, evaluate, and interpret data; to reason; to define problems; to establish facts; to draw valid conclusions; and to make effective judgments and decisions.
