Facility Development and Planning

Board Update

August 8, 2019

- City of Santa Clara Safe Routes to Schools and the SCUSD are planning an event for October 2, which is Walk, Roll and Bike to Work Day. The City is also ordering safety equipment and bike, skateboard and scooter racks for schools under the current Safe Routes to Schools Grant.
- Prop 39 Hughes/Montague Air Conditioning and Lighting Replacement Projects are finishing up. A new 80 ton chiller at Montague and a 60 ton chiller at Hughes (air conditioning for most of the campus) were installed with new boilers (heating), piping, and fans. Each classroom now has three supply vents and one return vent (some classrooms only had one or two supply vents). The classroom will be better ventilated and have flexible lighting with the new dimmable light switches that were installed. For the most part, the projects will be complete by the first day of schools. Fine tuning and commissioning the systems will occur after students are out of class each day.
- SCUSD / Stanford Summer Camp finished last week and everyone had a great time. Nutrition Services and the Farm Tour docent created education and fun for all age groups attending the camp. Lunch was served with fresh produce from the farm daily and each week ended with a personal pizza baked in the cob oven. Parents were welcomed on Friday's for the pizza lunch and the campers were able to show them what they learned during the past week. Many of the students are looking forward to attending next year.
- Use of Facilities/Facilitron: Terms and Conditions have been clarified and updated for the renters and Staff Guidelines and best practices were emailed out to Principals and other office staff. AR1330 has been updated to reflect the clarified user groups and fees. A discounted rate of \$5.00 per hour will be used for large organizations renting practice fields with over 80% SCUSD students on the team rosters. These organizations may include Little League and soccer. This rate includes either custodial services in permanent toilet rooms or portable toilets placed near the fields depending on the campus. Without the discount, these organizations would be paying \$15 per hour. The discount only applies to fields and not the use of buildings.
- The Ponderosa All Inclusive Playground started construction this week and the play equipment will be installed at the end of September.
