
In the past two years, we have implemented new application procedures and expectations including:

- A detailed and intensive application, requiring a reflective student essay, a teacher recommendation, and clarified information regarding payment and partial refunds for withdrawal.
- A participation contract with minimum academic, attendance, disciplinary, and behavioral expectations.
- Request for parental permission to search students' bags before boarding the bus to Yosemite.
- Adjustments to the budget that allow for a parent chaperone to attend in addition to the four teacher chaperones, reducing our ratio of adults to students.
- More detailed information on the academic benefits of the NatureBridge curriculum.

These efforts have insured that students retain their focus on the academic nature of the trip and are held to the highest standards of character in representing La Canada high school. In fact, the new procedures we adopted have now become a model for the district for off-campus field trips.

We are excited every year to take La Cañada High School students to one of our nation's premier National Parks for a unique cross-curricular learning experience, and we take great pride in the fact that this trip has become part of a meaningful 40+ year local tradition. We appreciate you submitting this trip to the Governing Board for approval and look forward to sharing stories of our experience with you all when we return from the trip next spring.

Rationale for activity:

- A) Explain the educational value and relate to the instructional program or sponsoring organization and Policy 1100.

Students learn about the natural sciences, leadership skills, group dynamics, history, and culture of the Yosemite National Park area. NatureBridge field science and nature writing curriculum is developed in alignment with Common Core and Next Generation Science Standards for public instruction and supports science and English curriculum classroom lessons at La Canada High School.

- B) Explain impact on instructional time and justification for any time lost.

This trip will impact four days of instruction this year due to the fact that Monday, 2/20/17, is part of the Presidents Day Holiday. Students participating in this trip must receive advance approval for missed instructional time from each teacher and are encouraged to bring work with them to Yosemite. The students must make up any work missed while they are gone and will be given opportunities during off-trail time to work on assignments independently and with chaperone assistance. Teacher chaperones must leave meaningful lesson plans for their substitute teachers for the instructional time that is missed.
