WHEREAS, the California Air Resource Board (CARB) is seeking applications for grants to purchase new lower-emission replacement school buses and retrofits; and

WHEREAS the Campbell Union School District Governing Board is aware that funding is available through the Carl Moyer Program for purchase of the cleanest available equipment, including zero-emissions and near-zero-emissions school buses and the charging or fueling infrastructure to support the use of these buses, and the Campbell Union School District was offered the opportunity to fund zero-emissions and near-zero-emissions school bus equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Campbell Union School District Governing Board authorizes the Assistant Superintendent of Administrative Services to submit a grant request and participate in the Lower Emission School Bus Program; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board also understands that although matching funds are not required, grantees are responsible for any costs over the Air District's award;
