**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Campbell Union School District's Governing Board is currently elected under an "at-large" election system, where Board members are elected by voters of the entire District. On September 19, 2019, the Board adopted Resolution #2019-20-10 declaring its intent to transition from at-large to by-trustee area Board elections, where each Board member must reside within the designated trustee area boundary, and is elected only by the voters in that trustee area.

Pursuant to Elections Code section 10010(a), before a political subdivision that is changing from an at-large method of election to a by-trustee area method of election draws a draft map or maps of the proposed boundaries of the trustee areas, the political subdivision shall hold at least two public hearings at which the public is invited to provide input regarding the composition of the trustee areas and the sequence of elections. On September 23, 2019, the Board will hold the first of the two statutorily required public hearings.
