Education Code Section 60119

**Certification of Provision of Standards-Aligned Instructional Materials
Resolution Regarding Sufficiency or Insufficiency of Instructional Materials:**

WHEREAS, the governing board of Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on October 3, 2019 at 5:30 p.m., which is on or before the end of the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

WHEREAS, the governing board provided at least 10 days' notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

WHEREAS, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders (if the district or county office has a bargaining unit) in the public hearing, and;

WHEREAS, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home to complete required homework assignments, and;

WHEREAS, all elementary students have sufficient textbooks and/or instructional materials in the following areas of study: English Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, and Health.

WHEREAS, secondary students at John Adams Middle School, Lincoln Middle School, Santa Monica High School, Olympic High School and Malibu High School have sufficient textbooks and/or instructional materials in the following areas of study: English Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, Foreign Language, and Health.

WHEREAS, sufficient laboratory science equipment was provided for science laboratory classes offered in grades 9-12, inclusive, and;

THEREFORE, it is resolved that for the 2019-2020 school year, the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum framework, as specified in Education Code section 60119.
