Purpose: To keep the Board up to date on efforts and events in Funding, Special Projects, Local Childcare Planning Council and at the Alpine Early Learning Center.

Funding and Special Projects

 The application for 2019-2020 Youthful Offender Block Grant funding through the Alpine County Probation Department will be submitted by the July 19 deadline. This is an application for funds to support PBIS implementation at both Diamond Valley and Bear Valley Elementary Schools. The program goal is to establish and maintain a positive learning environment where all students feel safe and able to engage in the learning process. The objectives are to reduce negative behaviors and increase consistency in attendance.

Alpine County Child Care Planning Council (LPC)

- The next regular LPC meeting is proposed for Friday, August 16 and will be confirmed before the next board meeting.
- The LPC is still recruiting for Consumers, Community Representatives, and Discretionary Appointees.

Alpine Early Learning Center (AELC)

- Summer program enrollment is 8 preschoolers and toddlers (3 are part time) and 6 infants.
- AELC has hired a summer aide to float between the infant and preschool groups, but there have been some technical delays in onboarding. The plan is to have her on duty the week after the maintenance closure.
- AELC will be closed for summer maintenance (preventative pest control, carpet cleaning, etc) for the week of July 8-12. Preschool/toddler program will resume July 15 and conclude July 31 (returning for the 2019-20 school year on August 12). The infant program runs continuously.
- State Preschool opens for enrollment in July. Natalie will be busy registering families for the upcoming year.
