





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

# Service by San Jose City College


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- Total = 4,477+ received college services with some duplication.

    - *Summer Robotics Camp*



# Milpitas Unified School District Activities at the Extension

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
- Total = 3,100+ MUSD students, parents, and staff received services at the Extension with some duplication
  - *Hosted 1 Milpitas High School class, meeting 5 periods a day during AY 18-19 \*Advanced Physics 130 students*
  - *Served as a work site for the special education work experience class. 6 students*
  - *Travel and Tourism Academy serving a total of 140 students*
  - *Study Hub for after school, 20-50 high school and junior high students*
  - *Served 522 high school students who took at least one college course (part CROA reporting)*
  - *Offered 4 dual enrollment courses that served 75 students*
  - *Hosted 89 Milpitas Unified School District events/sessions that served approximately 2,255 people*
  - *Milpitas Adult Education Meetings and ESL Classes. 50+ students*


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## By the Numbers

- **6 Math Acceleration Courses**
  - **209 MHS Students**
  - **95% Success Rate**
- **4 General Education Courses**
  - **161 MHS Students**
  - **94% Success Rate**

# Math Acceleration Success Rate

- The Majority of students who took a SJCC class continue to achieve at high levels of success.
- 65 MHS students successfully completed MATH 14 – College Geometry in the Summer 2018 semester.
- 51 of those students elected to take the Acceleration Exam.
- 47 students who took the exam accelerated one math level with a success rate of 95.7% .








# Strategic Planning

# Dual Enrollment Pathways

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- Increased collaboration and articulation between SJCC Milpitas Extension and MUSD that led to the creation of a University Studies Pathway through IGETC, a comprehensible pattern of courses that prospective students from California Community Colleges can complete to satisfy lower division General Education requirements at both UC and CSU.
  - *Target Population: Underrepresented Students*
  - *11th and 12th grade*
  - *2 courses per semester*
  - *First Course Guidance offered each semester*
- Next Steps:
  - *Family Information Nights*
  - *Determine best practices to ensure students' success*
  - *Targeted tutoring & mentoring*
