Background

Organisation History✓

Amar Seva Sangam is premier organization in the field of disability management. Our focus is on rural areas. Our approach is to establish a centralized resource center and act as a Catalyst for change in the development of the physically and mentally challenged. We do this by involving the village community in the process. The organization has been founded and run by physically challenged persons. We have built a strong team and infrastructure and deliver quality services at the local, regional and national levels.

Sri.S.Ramakrishnan who became a paraplegic due to a mishap when he was 21 years old while studying in an engineering college in Coimbatore established Amar Seva Sangam in the year 1981 in his native village Ayikudy about 5 Kms away from Tenkasi, in southern most part of Tamil Nadu. I am a Chartered Accountant and a wheel chair user, affected by muscular dystrophy, joined him in 1992 and we both with the blessings of God and people like you, strive towards the attainment of our dream, to build a Valley for the physically challenged.

Eminent persons like Bharath Rathna late Sri.C.Subramaniam became the Chief Patron of the organization, and Sri. N.Vaghul, Chairman, ICICI Bank and Sri.S.V.Mony, Chairman, Life Insurance Commission India, became the Patrons. Prof. Dr.M.S.Swaminathan, the father of Green revolution of India is the current Patron in Chief.

We are a registered society under Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act with the Registration No.TSI 16/1981. We are also a registered charity of 12A under Income Tax Act and also entitled to issue tax free donation receipts under section 80G of the Income Tax Act. We also enjoy 100% tax free receipts for donors under section 35AC of the Income Tax Act.

Amar Seva Sangam with the Motto "Live To Serve" has established an institution of reckoning in the field of disability sector and has been spearheading a village based rehabilitation model with a vision of making this area "valley for the disabled" where equality prevails among the disabled and non-disabled.

Started in a small way with just 8 children with disabilities we started the new initiative exclusively for the development of the disabled persons in 1991, 10 years after the establishment of Amar Seva Sangam. With the blessings of God and support of people like you we have established major facilities in the village of Ayikudy where several state-of-the-art-technology programms are provided for all the rehabilitation requirements of persons with disabilities from basic schooling to higher education, vocational rehabilitation, special education for mentally challenged, hostel for disabled children and youth, rehabilitation centre for Spinal Injured Patients and a medical testing / therapy unit. We have won several awards and recognitions across the country and internationally. At present we are catering to more than 13000 persons with disabilities in more than 800 villages in three Districts (Tirunelveli, Tuticorin, Virudhunagar) of Tamilnadu.

Our major source of funds is donations from public which constitutes about 70% of our income.

Individuals and philanthropists like you are our backbone of support. The impact of the organisation's activities is far and wide. We have raised our performance to prove to the people at large that disability is not a constraint but only a condition that is to be understood and lived with. About 91% of the people who get trained in our organisation are living with independence and dignity and earning a livelihood for themselves. The total number of persons with disabilities who have got direct rehabilitation from inception is 1102. The number of persons working in software industry in various metro cities is 9; the number of self employed is 147; the number of people doing higher education is 78; the number of self advocating leaders in the community is 1020.

Marriages of disabled with normal persons, acceptance of disabled persons in social functions, family functions and allowing entry of disabled persons in places of worships are some of the high-lights that can be seen in our area.

We played a major role in the enactment of persons with disabilities act by conducting a national level seminar under the Chairmanship of Sri V.R. Krishna Iyer (Rtd. Supreme Court Justice) and we are in the state level policy making board also in the field of disability. Here in our area all the temples, bus stations and railway stations are disabled friendly and accessible by all. We helped the Election Commission to conduct barrier free elections by making all the voting booths in the State accessible for disabled. We helped the Railways to design a special coach for physically challenged travellers and part of the disability rights movement which has enabled

nationwide air travel and train travel a hassle free affair for the disabled.

"Empowering the disabled citizens by establishing a 'Valley for the Disabled' as a Rehabilitation and Development Center for the region and developing models for self-help initiatives by integrating the disabled individuals with the society for improved living conditions in the village. "

Vision✓

It is our vision to establish a Valley for the Disabled, whereby physically/ mentally challenged persons live in a pro-active society where equality prevails irrespective of physical, mental or other challenged with the rest of the society. It is a futuristic vision whereby Amar Seva Sangam plays the role of an enabling agent to get the physically/mentally challenged "equality of status, equality in opportunities and equality in access". It is a society where people are identified as differentially abled.
