Monday, October 10, 2017 – District Wide Professional Development Day

Elementary General Education and Special Education teachers will be joining together in grade level teams for a district-wide professional development day at Prunedale Elementary with a focus on Language Arts Literacy, and Math Literacy.

Middle School General Education and Special Education teachers will gather at the Middle School for a morning focused on PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention Systems) and an afternoon for all departments to continue their work around Common Core State Standards (CCSS) units of study in English Language Arts and Science, grade calibration in mathematics, Social Studies Framework, and PE units of study.

At the high school, Central Bay, Independent Study, and the North County high school teachers will be uniting for a super opportunity to learn about the Redesign of SAT and the implications of linking the California standards to their day-to-day lessons. Teachers will be in sessions to put into action what they will learn about the 8 key changes to the SAT. (Evidence-based reading and writing, math and essay)

College and Career Day Scheduled for Wednesday, October 19th @ High School

- Big day and opportunity for all sophomores and juniors as teachers on campus will be proctoring our students taking the PSAT.
- All freshmen will be involved with exploring Career Technical Education pathways. The class will be divided into 3 groups and the students will be traveling by bus to visit MCOE media center, Hartnell's Alisal campus which includes a presentation on Steps to Success and a tour of the campus, and concluding with meeting with our very own CTE teachers and their classrooms on the campus at the high school.
