

### Rationale for Activity

#### Part A

The Santa Barbara Tournament of Champions is the most competitive high school girls water polo tournament in the country. This incredibly elite tournament is open by select invitation only based on the competitive level of the team, their CIF division, and the potential for their success in the tournament. The prestige of this tournament attracts the best college coaches where they are able to complete the majority of their recruiting. This is the first time in the history of the La Cañada Girls' Water Polo program that we have received an invitation. This tournament will provide the opportunity for the athletes to see and compete at the highest level of high school water polo. The Tournament of Champions is also the best opportunity to prepare the athletes for their jump into Div II of CIFSS. Additionally, the travel aspect of the tournament will provide quality team time as well as the first hand experience of what it means to be a student athlete at the next level. This will teach the athletes responsibility for their time management, communication skills as they work with their teachers for missed time, and provide an incredible opportunity for maturation. The location of the tournament will provide the opportunity for all students to experience an on campus tour of the beautiful and prestigious UC Santa Barbara. Every student will experience what it is truly like to be an elite student athlete.

#### Part B

Student will be out of school for Friday 1/13 and a portion of Thursday 1/12. The partial day Thursday will be dependent on the tournament schedule, but students will be kept in school as long as possible to minimize the academic impact. All student athletes are aware of their responsibilities as a student. Each student will begin the conversation with their teachers on the first day of the semester, letting them know of their schedule and the time that will be missed. Each student will provide a personalized letter to each teacher explaining the importance of the tournament as well as their commitment to excellence as a student-athlete. They will schedule make-up tests prior to the trip and get all school work prior to leaving. While on the trip, study hall hours will exceed the amount of instructional time missed providing each student with adequate time to study and complete school work. Both coaches will be available during study hall to proctor tests and/or tutor student-athletes.
