1. How is the afterschool program aligned with the school day?

The Program Specialist and the Instructional Technicians make an effort in reaching out to Classroom Teachers and the Special Education Department for the most up to date information on Students and Curriculum. The Program Specialist meets weekly with the Principal, Parent Liaison, Custodian, Counselor and Literacy Coach, keeping the flow of communication between the school day and the after school program.
