1. How is the afterschool program aligned with the school day?

The program specialist meets with the principal and RTI coaches regularly to discuss case management and academic intervention. The program specialist and ITs meet with grade-level teams of teachers every 6 weeks to discuss academic support hour, classroom expectations and behavior management.

2. What differentiates the afterschool program from the school day?

The program specialist and ITs see certain parents a lot more than the principal or teachers do, so they serve as an important link between the school day and home. Students participate in a wide variety of enrichment classes after school, often doing things that the teachers have voiced they don't have enough time for during the school day (doing art, playing academic games, etc.)

3. If there is a BEARS program at your site, how are the two programs integrated?

The two programs are completely integrated. The only difference is which binder the parents sign out of. There is absolutely no difference for the students and what they do in the program.

4. What are your site's goals for the year?

After school program staff will develop their skills in providing a safe, inclusive space for our diverse student population. Staff have attended multiple trainings on equity and the gender spectrum this school year.
