SMUHSD LCAP Goal #1

SMUHSD will provide high quality teaching and learning environments to all students by:

- Providing 21st Century facilities & learning tools (digital and analog) to all students
- Ensuring access to the highest quality staff -- educators, support staff and leaders -- who receive effective and differentiated professional development
- Providing equitable access to a broad course of study that is rigorous, culturally responsive and relevant, and aligned to the CA Standards and 21st Century skills



■ Goal #1 - Actions & Services

- Implement Professional Development Plan:
 - Refine Instructional Framework
 - Continue Professional Learning Communities
 - Instructional Coaching
 - New Teacher PD
 - PD Coordinators
- Implement 2016-19 Technology Initiatives:
 - 1:1 Teacher Chromebook Cart Program - 49 new carts 16-17 (37+ proposed for next year)
 - Pilot *Canvas* Learning Management System
 - Instructional Tech Coordinators



2.Goal #1 Methodology



■ LCAP Goal #1 Measurable Outcomes

15 metrics being tracked/set for 2016-17:

- Facilities: FIT Reports
- Highly qualified staff: Credentials
- Instructional materials: Access
- Equitable course enrollment: AP/IB & CTE
- 10th Grade students: On-Track for Graduation



■ LCAP Measurement: *Growth & Status*

Status = current rate or percentage of metric

Growth = The extent to which the district met the growth target it set for itself on the respective metric

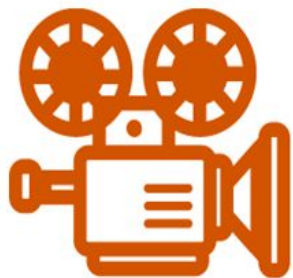

■ Analysis & Implications

AP/IB Enrollment: needs improvement - we expect to see increases given *PSAT AP Potential Identification*

CTE Completion: Competing priorities produce mixed results - new investments should prompt improvements

10th Grade Readiness: Overall excellent, but persistent gaps - sites are focusing more intervention/support/monitoring at 9th grade level
