SUBJECT: Resignations

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A County Board of Education member who wishes to resign shall file a written resignation with the County Superintendent of Schools, as Secretary to the County Board of Education, and with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

The resignation shall become effective when filed, unless a deferred effective date is specified in the written resignation. The effective date may not be deferred for more than 45 days after filing.

A written resignation, whether specifying a deferred effective date or otherwise, shall be irrevocable once filed.

A County Board member who tenders his/her resignation with a deferred effective date shall, until the effective date of the resignation, continue to exercise all the powers of the office except those involving the appointment of his/her successor.

Within 30 days of leaving office, a County Board member who resigns shall file a revised Statement of Economic Interest/Form 700 covering the period of time between the closing date of the last statement and the date he/she leaves office.
