

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF PETALUMA CITY ELEMENTARY DISTRICT OF THE
COUNTY OF SONOMA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA TO DETERMINE THE SUFFICIENCY OF TEXTBOOKS OR
INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS.

WHEREAS, the governing board of Petaluma City Schools, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on November 15th, 2021 at 5:00 p.m., and;

WHEREAS, the governing board provided at least 10 day notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

WHEREAS, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders (if the district or county office has a bargaining unit) in the public hearing, and;

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English

WHEREAS, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

WHEREAS, between the 2008-09 through the 2021-22 fiscal years, the definition of “sufficient textbooks or instructional materials” also means that all students who are enrolled in the same course within the Petaluma City Elementary District, have standards-aligned textbooks or instructional materials from the same adoption cycle, and;

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:

- Mathematics
- Science
- History-social science
- English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials were provided to each pupil enrolled in foreign language or health classes, and

WHEREAS, laboratory science equipment was available for science laboratory classes offered in grades 9- 12, inclusive;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that for the 2021-22 school year, the Petaluma City Schools District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
