RESOLUTION No. 15-16-19**

APPROVAL OF VIDEO SECURITY SOLUTION RFP PROCESS

WHEREAS, the Irvine Unified School District ("District") wishes to procure an integrated security camera and management system and related services to support safety of IUSD campuses, and

WHEREAS, technology-based video security camera and management systems are of a specialized and unique nature; and

WHEREAS, video security solutions are undergoing significant and constant changes to incorporate new technologies and increase video quality and management functionality; and

WHEREAS, the District has need of an effective, centrally-managed security system that integrates with related IUSD technology systems; and

WHEREAS, there has been a proliferation of services and products to meet security needs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Contract Code section 20118.2, school districts are allowed to acquire technology systems related services through a Request for Proposal ("RFP") process that takes into account system capabilities and other factors in addition to cost; and

WHEREAS, the District intends to publish an RFP for the acquisition a video security solution, with the following evaluation components: (1) Price -30%, (2) Management/Software Solution – 25%, (3) Cameras and Site Technology – 15%, (4) Technical Requirements and Interoperability– 15%, and (5) Vendor Support and Ability to Perform – 15%.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE IRVINE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, ORDER, AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The District's proposed procurement of a Video Security Solution and related services qualifies as procurement under Public Contract Code section 20118.2 and is hereby authorized by the Board.

2. The following evaluation factors and the percentages assigned to each factor are hereby authorized and approved: *(1) Price -30%, (2) Management/Software Solution – 25%, (3) Cameras and Site Technology – 15%, (4) Technical Requirements and Interoperability– 15%, and (5) Vendor Support and Ability to Perform – 15%.*

3. The award of the RFP and authorization for the Assistant Superintendent of Business Services to enter into a contract between the District and selected provider shall be taken by separate Board action.
