

Irvine Unified School District PE Reporting

This is a report prepared for Irvine Unified School District by Stan Machesky (Superintendent's Designee) regarding compliance with CAL200 settlement agreement for July 2015 through December 2015.

- A. Class Schedules: I have contacted all school principals (or designees) regarding obtaining the schedule from each classroom in grades 1 through 6 showing the days, times, and duration of the scheduled Physical Education instruction. All principals (or designees) have obtained the class schedules except for the following schools:

- B. Publication of Physical Education Schedules: All Physical Education schedules are posted on our District's website or in each classroom and the schedules are posted in the schools' main office except the following:

- C. Reporting: The principals (or designees) in each school with grades 1 through 6 have obtained the reporting forms from each teacher except the following schools:

- D. Monitoring: Each teacher is required to sign the reporting forms, acknowledging that the required physical education minutes were met (each pupil is to receive not less than 200 minutes of physical education each 10 school days, exclusive of recesses and the lunch period). In addition, the principals (or designees) have made at least two unannounced visits to at least two classrooms per month during the time that physical education was scheduled. The principals' reports which document these unannounced visits have been provided to the superintendent. All principals (or designees) in each school with grades 1 through 6 have been contacted regarding the monitoring component of the settlement agreement. According to the reports provided, physical education was observed by the principals (or designees) which showed compliance with the requirement except for the following schools:

- E. Reports to the Governing Board: Within 60 days of the end of the semester, the Superintendent (or Superintendent's designee) provided this report to the District's Governing Board.
