**WHEREAS**, the District honors the cultural heritage of Native Americans;

**WHEREAS**, the District seeks to promote awareness, understanding, and good relations among indigenous peoples and all other segments of our District; and

**WHEREAS**, the District honors our nation's indigenous roots, history, and contributions.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Twin Rivers Unified School District Board of Trustees encourages District staff to include the teaching of the history, culture, and governments of the indigenous peoples of our state.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that November 2017 be recognized as Native American Heritage Month and encourages the district to recognize our families who continue to practice the teachings of their ancestors and ensure that our students know and respect the history of America's indigenous people.
