Minor changes to signage, the installation of a meeting board, interior changes to accommodate the City Council, possible minor work at the overflow space either in the breezeway of the school (first period of time) or the boys' gymnasium (future plan). When the Board Room project was initially conceived, the plan was that the City Council would also hold public meetings at this location. Additionally, the Council used the site for three months as a pilot. Increased usage of the facility is only estimated to be two nights a week.
