The Why

- ▶ Every CUSD school will be a School of Choice.
“Every parent would choose to enroll their child in any of the CUSD schools.”

 - ▶ Strategic Plan Objective
 - ▶ Identify two pilot sites
 - ▶ Campbell Middle School
 - ▶ Blackford

 - ▶ District Goal
 - ▶ Turn around plan for Campbell Middle School
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Village Plan

▶ Survey Administered

▶ Results of the survey

- ▶ 26.2% In favor of the consolidation
- ▶ 62.5% Against the consolidation with the timeline presented

▶ Teachers' Position

▶ March 31 Board meeting

- ▶ Decided not to endorse the consolidation

▶ Communication Plan Development

- ▶ Task Force will be convened to examine the special qualities Village offers its students and community
 - ▶ Joint Village/CUSD letter to the CUSD community
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Campbell Middle School Plan

- ▶ Survey Administered to staff to identify key areas of concentration
 - ▶ Leadership Task Force created to address a proposal for rethinking CMS by May 1
 - ▶ Communication Plan will be developed in order to keep the community informed
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The Blackford Plan

- ▶ In April, meet with the staff to review the Schools of Choice proposal.
 - ▶ In June, work with the staff to determine the specific resources needed at the site.
 - ▶ In the fall, develop an implementation calendar.
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Considerations

- ▶ More time is needed to develop a comprehensive CMS and Blackford plan with check points.
 - ▶ Formal and informal opportunities for dialogue must increase.
 - ▶ Include community in the process
 - ▶ Frequent communication using multiple media is needed!
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Next Steps

- ▶ Send a communication to the district/community regarding the Village community survey results.
 - ▶ Create a joint District/CMS task force to study possible K-8 structures, visit other K-8 schools, and develop a comprehensive plan.
 - ▶ Determine timelines/check points for the following year by August 2016.
