**RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THAT THE MILLBRAE SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS PROVIDED EACH PUPIL WITH
STANDARDS-ALIGNED TEXTBOOKS AND MATERIALS IN THE FOUR CORE ACADEMIC SUBJECTS**

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Millbrae School District, in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code Section 60119 held a public hearing on September 18, 2018 at 7:30 pm, which is before the eighth week of school and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

WHEREAS, the Governing Board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places with the district and stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing and;

WHEREAS, the Governing Board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and the Governing Board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English Learners, in the Millbrae School District, and;

WHEREAS, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English Learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:

Mathematics
Science
History-Social Science
English/Language Arts

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED for 2018-2019 the Millbrae School District has provided each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
