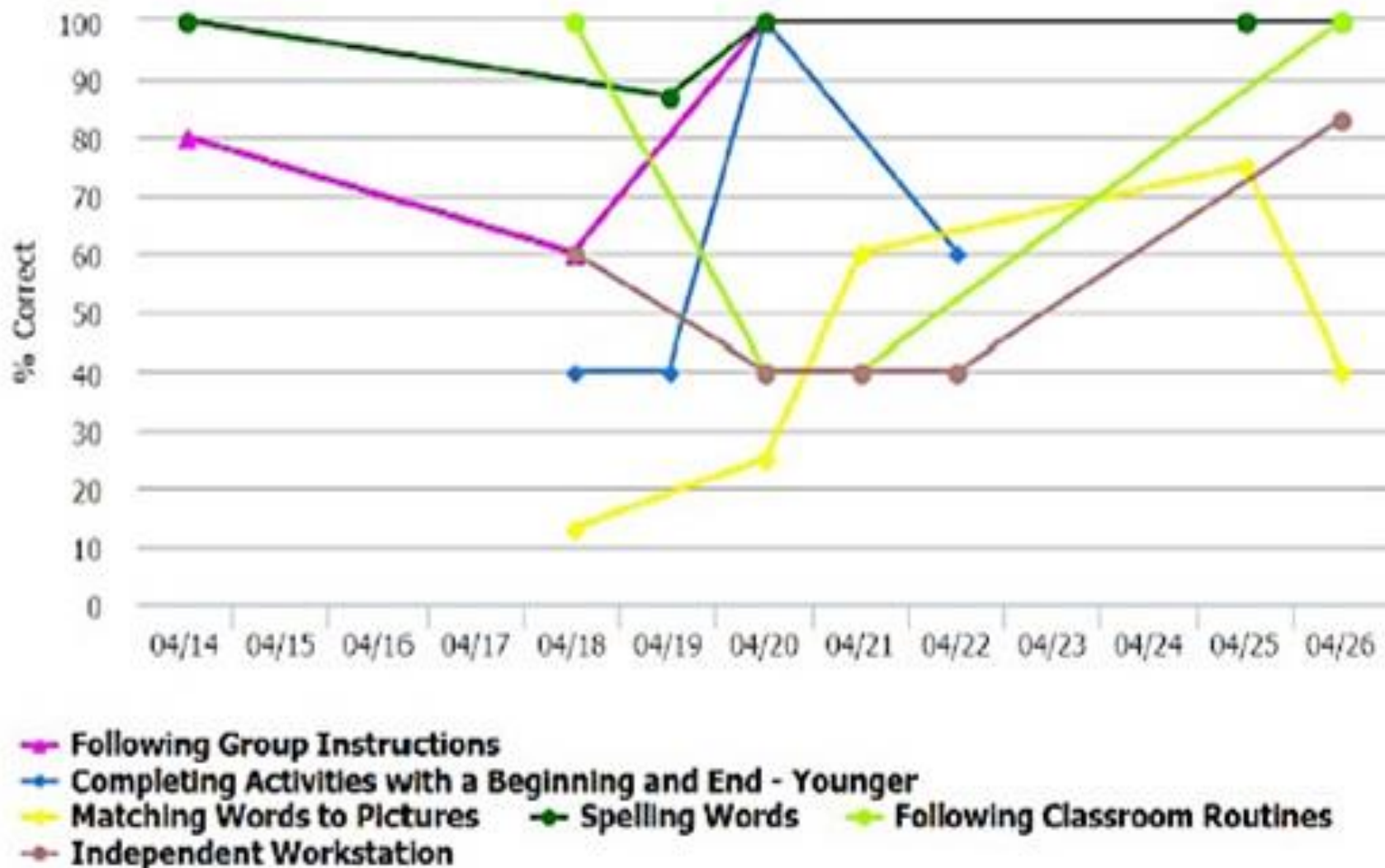

Update on Preschool Inclusion

Identified Needs

- ❑ Partnering with the Inclusion Collaborative SCCOE
- ❑ Pilot to begin at Forest Hill
- ❑ Professional Development:
Inclusive Classroom Profile
- ❑ Developing Philosophy statement
- ❑ ReThink is also being used to make data driven decisions for student learning

Update

- ❑ Bimonthly meetings with Inclusion Collaborative
- ❑ Pilot started on first day of school and will continue through June 8
- ❑ Inclusive Classroom Profile training will be available during the 2016-17 school year
- ❑ Philosophy statement was developed in August, 2015
- ❑ Participated in an Embedded Instruction pilot for the University of Florida and data has been collected using their learning target and data collection forms

Update on ASD Programs

Identified Needs

- ❑ Establish a baseline of knowledge.
- ❑ Identifying common profile markers/observations within the ASD population.
- ❑ Provide continuum of programs to support students on autism spectrum K-8.
- ❑ Share tips for teaching & supporting social thinking throughout continuum.
- ❑ Provide quality data-driven programs that support student learning.
- ❑ Provide opportunities in the mainstream to generalize learned skills.

Updates

- ❑ Continuum of ASD Programs developed to support students on the autism spectrum for all grades.
- ❑ All staff trained in Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) & data collection.
- ❑ Common vocabulary related to Social Thinking curriculum is used by all staff throughout continuum.
- ❑ Programs are behaviorally based with interventions designed to meet the individual needs of each student.
- ❑ Data collection continues to be supported through ReThink.
