NEW BUS SHELTER PHOTOVOLTAIC PANEL PROJECT

WHEREAS, concerning the construction of a new bus shelter with photovoltaic panels installation at Campbell Union School District, Corporate Yard, 240 Harrison Ave, Campbell, CA 95008 shall not be used for instructional purposes, and that no pupils or teachers or the public will be permitted to use or enter the bus shelter for said purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the following:

- The Governing Board of the Campbell Union School District directs the Administration as follows:
 1. Plans must be prepared by a California licensed Architect or Engineer.
 2. The school board assumes responsibility for adequate inspection of the materials and work of construction to ensure compliance with the provisions of Parts 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, and 12, Title 24, C.C.R., as adopted by the California Building Standards Commission.
 3. To provide a disconnect location which is identified and accessible for fire department fire-fighting operations. Architect/Engineer of record to coordinate with local utility provider for requirements regarding connection to service.
- That the Governing Board hereby adopts the resolution.
