All students will be actively engaged, encouraged and supported by a high-quality staff and an educational experience that supports their mastery of state and district learning standards.

What we planned	What we accomplished
Maintain Class size average of 17 or lower to allow for more individualized support.	Class sizes range from 8 to 19. Average per grade level is 5.7. Average per teacher is 13. One class (grades 1/2) is at 19. This section has support from the intervention teacher four days per week.
Provide Professional Learning Training to all staff for Project-Based Learning and standards-aligned instruction	Not yet started this year.
Support improved student attendance with Attendance Awards and revising current Board Attendance Policy and Interdistrict Transfer Policy to include Attendance/Behavior Contract.	Brief discussion has occurred with teachers about the best way to manage Awards. Revision of Board Policies pending clarification of intent.
Continue to Collaborate with the Buellton Recreation Department Staff to bring enrichment opportunities.	Uncertain of status. Afterschool music program (Ukeleles) is under way.
Continue to offer after school drama and sports offerings	Not yet started this year.

Administer universal screener (STAR/Renaissance Learning) and administer on a quarterly basis.	Report on progress to be shared at October Board meeting.
Provide Professional Learning Training to all staff in the area of Differentiation	Not started.
Rtl support will be built into the master schedule.	Intervention teacher present, time increased from .4 FTE to .7 FTE.
MTSS Grant Implementation (District received grant with 2017-2018 application – an LCAP action)	Grant application was approved, initial training of Intervention Teacher is underway. All teachers had presentation on social emotional curriculum, “Second Step” at October 8 Professional Development Day.

Implement Second Step in grades 4-6 to address student harassment (Note: Implementation goal in 7-8 last year)	Implementation in grades 7-8 was not achieved. This year the MTSS grant will allow purchase, training and implementation at all grade levels this year.
Contract for Services to improve Campus Maintenance and Cleanliness	Uncertain of the status of this action. Will report at October Board meeting.
Contract for Facilities Use Advertising and Coordination	Continuing action from 2017-2018.

What we planned	What we accomplished
Invest in parent and community communication to include improving district website, continued implementation of ParentSquare and creation of a monthly school newsletter	Parent Square is in place and functioning. Contract with WestEd to survey parents in order to solicit information about school perceptions	Uncertain of the status of this action. Will report at October Board meeting.
